

Why We're Saying **No** to **ROBLOX**

1. Roblox has dangers

Strangers can pretend to be kids. Some games show bad things. God does not want our hearts or eyes set upon bad things. (Psalm 119:37)

2. Roblox teaches the wrong identity

4. Roblox can be addicting

Roblox has ways of tricking you to want to spend money you don't have to buy things that you don't need. The Bible says whatever controls you becomes your master (2 Peter 2:19).

5. God offers something better than Roblox

Real joy is found in Jesus (Philippians 4:4) We don't need the virtual world of Roblox to have fun. God gave us family, friends, His creation, and His Word to live a life of adventure and fun.
