Family Conversation Guide

Talking About Sora and Al:

These questions are important EVEN IF your child isn't asking for Sora because it will help them think critically about Al.

False Realities...

- 1. What do you think makes people so excited about Sora?
 - If they don't know anythina about Sora use the Brave Parentina Guide to Sora to explain its basics emphasizing that none of the videos are real. Then ask again, why are people so excited?
- 2. Do you think creating a video on Sora is the same as creating something with hands? (Why or why not?)
- 3. What do you think will happen when people can't determine what is true online? What about when they stop caring about what is real and true?

Cameos...

- 4. What's the worst imaginable video that someone could make with your likeness and voice?
- 5. Is it okay to make a video of someone who didn't say or do things, even if it's funny?
- 6. How do you think "cameos" could distort reality and cause confusion?

Scripture...

- 7. What does it mean to bear God's image? (Gen 1:27)
 - We bear his likeness, so when our likeness is disparaged, it reflects our Creator whose image we bear.
- 8. How is what God did in Genesis, speaking creation into existence, different from what people do on Sora?

 God is self-existent: God was not created by human hands like Al programs are. Christ, the Son, is the embodiment of Truth: Al can only mimic the divine attributes of Creator of life and truth.
- 9. Why do you think God values truth so much? What (who) does the Bible say truth is?

 John 14:6 tells us Jesus is the truth. Truth matters because it is who God is. As believers, we are to live and love truth, reflecting the One whose image we bear.

Setting the Standard:

"We've decided that our family will not be using Sora. This isn't because we are afraid of technology but because we believe what God has created is already enough. He has given us His image. His truth, and His life in Jesus Christ, and we want to use technology in way that glorifies Him and points people back to their Creator rather than to confusion."
